**Location:** The Columbia Club is located at the center of downtown Indianapolis on Monument Circle. It is walking distance to Banker's Life Fieldhouse, Hilbert Circle Theatre/Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra, Indiana Convention Center, Lucas Oil Stadium, Circle Centre shopping mall, and more.

Nearby is the NCAA Experience Museum, the new Indiana State Museum, Eiteljorg Museum, White River Gardens, Canal Walk, Indianapolis Zoo and International Orangutan Center, White River State Park, National Institute of Fitness and Sports, Indiana History Museum, Indianapolis Children's Museum and Victory Field, home of the Indianapolis Indians baseball team.

The Columbia Club is three blocks from the State Capitol Building and the Indiana Government Center, which both state legislators and lobbyists find very convenient.

**Airport:** The Columbia Club is located eight miles east of the Indianapolis International Airport. Limousine, town car, ride share, Uber, and taxi services are available door-to-door. **Parking:** Valet parking is available at the club entrance 24 hours a day. Daytime valet rates are \$15. Overnight valet rates are \$25 with one complimentary in/out service. Several self-park garages are within walking distance of the Club.

### **Historic**

**Clubhouse:** The Columbia Club was chartered in 1889 as a marching society to elect the 23<sup>rd</sup> President of the United States, Benjamin Harrison. The third clubhouse on the same site, this clubhouse was cornerstoned in 1924, completed in 1925, and listed on the National Register of Historic Landmarks in 1983, a key to the city's historic center district.

### **Overnight**

**Accommodations:** The Club has 88 beautifully appointed overnight guest rooms and suites. Guest rooms are designed to resemble a lovely private home, in contrast to commercial hotels. Room service is available.

**Dining:** There are two dining rooms, a lounge, coffee bar and outdoor (seasonal) café. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and cocktail service is available Monday through Saturday, with limited service on Sunday. Executive Chef is Rolf Meisterhans.

**Dress Code:** All persons are required to wear neat and clean smart business casual attire at ALL times in all "common areas" of the Clubhouse. "Smart business casual attire" includes: coat and/or tie, pantsuit, dress, collared shirt, golf shirt, sweaters, turtleneck sweaters, slacks, denim, and dress shorts.

Jacket required when dining in The Harrison Room.

Not permitted or appropriate: torn or 'worn' clothing, cut-off shorts, tee shirts, tank/tube/halter tops, overalls/work clothes, bare midriff garments, clothes designed for a fitness area. No hats or caps except when appropriate for a Club event.

### **Platinum**

**Status:** The Columbia Club is a Platinum Club of America, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015. The Club ranks in the top 50 city clubs in America. Platinum status is awarded through selection by the managers and presidents of America's 6,000 private clubs.

### **Conference and Special Events:**

The Columbia Club has 25,000 square feet and 18 options for private meeting areas to accommodate small events, groups of 3-10, to large events, groups of up to 300. The Columbia Club is a preferred destination for important business meetings, wedding receptions, special family events, and more. The catering department offers innovative and flexible options with both pre-planned menus and signature cuisine to make any event memorable.

Full audio-visual services are available from our on-site provider. Complimentary 70mgb wi-fi is available throughout the clubhouse.

**Fitness Center:** The fitness center offers a variety of cardio equipment, a full line of BodyMasters resistance machines, 6,000<sup>+</sup> lbs of free weights, flat and incline/decline benches, smith machine, dip & pull-up station, a dual cable machine, and spin bikes. Both men's and women's locker rooms include: whirlpool, steam, sauna, showers and a lounge area. Personal training services and classes are available.

**Massage:** A massage therapist is on staff and is available by appointment for men's and women's massage. The Club is also affiliated with a full-service salon and day spa located on Monument Circle, just a block away.

**Member Services:** Monthly club-in-club meetings, seasonal activities, monthly and unique special events are organized by members and staff, and hosted at the clubhouse.

Personal Services include Concierge, Barbershop, Shoe Shop, ATM, Car Hire, Car Wash, Business Office, Electric Car Charging station, Notary, Laundry & Dry-Cleaning, Website

**Billing Information** The Columbia Club's standard reciprocal agreement requires reciprocal guests to pay their bill prior to departure by credit card or cash. Credit card payments will be subject to a 3% convenience fee.
